

Preventive care services for children

What is preventive care?

Preventive care includes tests, shots (vaccines), screenings and other care to help your children avoid illness before they have symptoms of a problem.

Your Marketplace plan pays the full cost of certain preventive care services from a doctor or other providers in your plan's network. This means you don't have to pay a copay or co-insurance or meet your deductible.

Preventive care services for children covered by your Marketplace plan

Your children may not need all of these services. Ask their doctor which services your children should get based on their sex, age and family history:

Regular visits

- Well-baby
- Well-child



Counseling

- Depression
- Weight loss
- Healthy eating



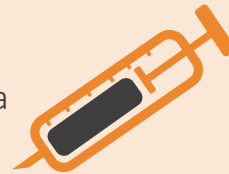
Tests and screenings

- Blood pressure
- Height, weight and body mass index (BMI)
- Hematocrit or hemoglobin
- Hepatitis B
- Lead
- Lipid
- Tuberculosis
- Vision
- Dental health



Vaccines

- Chickenpox
- Diphtheria, Tetanus, Whooping Cough
- Flu
- Hepatitis A and B
- Measles
- Meningitis
- Pneumonia
- Polio
- Rotavirus
- Others



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Development and behavior screenings

- Autism
- Alcohol and drug use
- Behavioral assessments
- Development screening



Newborn tests, medicines and screenings

- Eye medicine to prevent gonorrhea
- Screening for genetic disorders: phenylketonuria (PKU) and sickle cell
- Hearing
- Hypothyroidism



Other

- Fluoride supplements
- Iron supplements
- Medical history



Sexually transmitted disease (STD) screenings

- Cervical dysplasia
- HIV
- Sexually transmitted infection (STI) counseling
